Treasured Tote in the Hoop

In our class this month (February) we will explore and review the top features within our amazing Husqvarna Viking sewing and embroidery machine. There is a bag for every occasion, and this fun tote bag is an example of how fun and easy bag making can be! You will learn creative ways to use your machine, explore some of your machine's decorative stitches, make appliques, and how to stitch this in the hoop project bag. What a great little lined bag to tote some of your supplies to class each month!

Supply List

Husqvarna Viking Sewing and Embroidery Machine, Foot Control Pedal, Power Cord, Zig Zag and Single Hole Stitch Plate; A, B, S, Sensor Q, Edge Joining and Open Toe Foot, 360 x 260 hoop and for the DS 85 and DT 65 machine owners: the 360 mm x 200 mm hoop.

Note: There are a very limited number of fabric kits (2 fabric/stabilizer/zipper/thread kits, \$35.00 each and 1 fabric/stabilizer/zipper kit for \$25.00) available for purchase at Patty's. Call the store right away if you wish to purchase one. Otherwise you will need to provide your own fabric, zipper and stabilizers to include the In-R-Form batting as outlined in the supply list below.

Fabrics: 1/3 yard of three different fabrics. Choose one print and two coordinating fabrics that are solid colors. (Note a piece of black vinyl, 6" x 3", for applique will be provided in class)

Zipper – 20" Nylon coil zipper with 16mm zipper tape (Zippers by the Yard with extra large zipper pulls work well for the in the hoop tote bag)

Tear-Away stabilizer to fit embroidery hoop

In-R-Form batting: Cut (1) 12" x 19"

Fusible Fleece: Cut (2) 6" x 19"

Heat-n-Bond Lite Fusible web: Cut (1) 4" x 4" (**Available to purchase at Patty's by the yard**)

40wt Embroidery threads in multiple colors to contrast or match the fabrics

Embroidery Bobbin thread

24" x 6" ruler, rotary cutter and mat

Small Scissors and snips

Non-permanent fabric marker (**Available for purchase at Patty's**)

Embroidery Perfection Tape or Blue Painter's Tape

HV ® Topstitch needle, size 80 or Embroidery needle, size 90 (**Available for purchase at Patty's**)

Embroidery Bobbin Thread

General Sewing Supplies and Tools: such as Pins, Snips, Scissors, Seam Ripper, Rotary Cutter with sharp blade; non-permanent fabric marking pen, Rulers to mark fabric and stabilizer, to include 18" long ruler, etc.

Prep for class: Starch the fabrics.

From the print fabric: Cut (1) 12" x 19"; (1) 16 x 26"; (1) 4" x 4" and (2) 3 x 20" for bag straps

From one of the solid fabrics: Cut (1) 6" x 6" and (1) 19" x 6"

From second solid fabric: Cut (2) 6" x 8" and (3) 19" x 6"
