Love My Machine Pillow
12” x 14” pillow

This month (May), the first month of two to complete this project, we will continue exploring the features of our amazing Husqvarna Viking machines. In embroidery mode we will stitch out the designs used on the side and back of the pillow and the section using glitter flex for an appliqued machine and then stitch out rows of decorative stitches. In our class in June, we will stitch out an omni motion stitch and then construct our pillow. This cute pillow will make an excellent addition to the chair in your sewing room or a wonderful gift for any sewing friend.

Supply List

Husqvarna Viking Sewing and Embroidery Machine, Foot Control Pedal, Power Cord, Zig Zag and Single Hole Stitch Plate; A Foot, B Foot, S Foot, Sensor Q Foot, Invisible Zipper Foot, Hoops -- 260 mm x 200 mm **and** the 360 mm x 260 mm.

Fabrics: *Fabric kit available for purchase at Patty's* which includes ½ yd. of black fabric; ¼ yd. of cream fabric; 6” square of Glitter Flex; ½ yd. Lace trim; 12” of Measuring Tape Trim; ½ yd. Fusible Fleece.

All Students will need to supply the following:

Tear Away Stabilizer - 12” x 16”

Whisper Web Stabilizer – 10” x 12” and 8” x 12”

40 wt. embroidery threads for quilting designs and decorative stitches (sample used black and cream color threads)

Bobbins with white embroidery bobbin thread and black embroidery bobbin thread

Sewing thread and matching bobbin for construction of the pillow

20” Invisible Zipper (will need for class in June)

Blue painter's tape or embroidery perfection tape

Fabric Glue Stick

12” x 14” Pillow Form

Non-permanent marking pen or chalk to show on black fabric

24" x 6" ruler, rotary cutter and mat

Small Scissors and snips

HV ® Topstitch needle, size 90

General Sewing Supplies and Tools: such as Pins, Snips, Scissors, Seam Ripper, Rotary Cutter with sharp blade; non-permanent fabric marking pen, Rulers to mark fabric and stabilizer, to include long ruler, etc.

Prep for class: Pick up fabric kit from Patty's before class and starch the black and cream fabrics then cut the fabrics as outlined below:

From the black fabric: Cut (1) 18" x 18"; (1) 5 ½" x 9 ½"; (1) 12 ½" x 17"

From the cream fabric: Cut (1) 6" x 9 ½"; (1) 4" x 9 ½"

From the fusible fleece: Cut (1) 18" x 18"; (1) 12 ½" x 17" and then fuse to the back of the starched black fabric measuring 18" x 18" and 12 ½" x 17"
