

Design Shaping and Lettering Exercises

We will continue our exploration of the features within our sewing and embroidery machine as we explore the Design Shaping and Lettering features within our machine. Design Shaping is a unique way to take your creativity to another level. Use the built-in stitches or embroidery designs to create new Embroidery Design shapes. We will explore the different tools within Design Shaping to see how we can use this awesome feature. Then we will stitch out one of the exercises using the lovely built in dragonfly design. I have stitched this design out on the side of a tote bag. You could elect to do the same or just stitch it out on a piece of fabric. The choice is yours! The lettering exercise explores the many options available when you personalize a project using lettering. Note in class we will only have time to stitch out the dragonfly design.



Supply List

Husqvarna Viking Sewing and Embroidery Machine, Embroidery Arm, Foot Control Pedal, Power Cord, Sensor Q Foot, Single Hole Stitch Plate, 360 mm x 260 mm (DS 85 360 mm x 200 mm) and 260 mm x 200 mm hoops.

Rubber-tipped stylus to use on the capacitive touch screen on your machine

Inspira Topstitch 80 needle (**Available for purchase at Patty's**)

Tear Away Stabilizer – will need at least one piece to fit your hoop. (if using light weight tear away you will want to use 2 layers (**Available for purchase at Patty's**))

A piece of fabric or a tote bag to stitch the dragonfly design out on. Note if using a premade tote bag use a seam ripper and undo the sides of the bag before class. The actual design measures approximately 8" x 8". If planning to stitch the design out on fabric for a future project consider fusing a piece of fusible fleece to the back of your fabric and allow enough extra fabric around the outside of the design area for the project you have in mind.

40 wt. Rayon or Polyester Embroidery Threads for the dragonfly stitch out. You will want 2 shades of a blue, 3 shades of a purple, 3 shades of a green and an eggshell/light yellow or off-white color.

The original design used RA 2206, Baby Blue; RA 2528, Atlantis Blue; RA 2285, Violet; RA 2482, Skylight; RA 2288, Iris; RA 2547, Pebblestone; RA 2238, Mint; RA 2449, Fern Green and RA 2343, Eggshell.

These thread colors are provided to assist you in selecting colors of your choice to stitch out the design.

Embroidery Bobbin Thread (**Available for purchase at Patty's**) **Note:** If stitching the design out on a light color fabric – use white bobbin thread. If stitching the design out on a dark color fabric – use black bobbin thread.

Straight pins and curved safety pins.

General Sewing Supplies and Tools (such as Pins, Snips, Scissors, Seam Ripper, Rotary Cutter with sharp blade; non-permanent fabric marking pen, Rulers to mark fabric and stabilizer, etc.)
