Applique Made Easy Wall Hanging Project by Karen Charles

(Finished size is approx. 18" w x 22" L)



In our class this month (February) we will explore and review the top features within our amazing Husqvarna Viking sewing and embroidery machine. Creating beautiful and unique applique quilts is easier than ever using your embroidery machine. Karen Charles, a HV Educator, designed this fun wall hanging to show us how we can take any design or clip art and with our embroidery software create a lovely one-of-a-kind wall hanging. In class we will review how Karen created this design so that in the future you could create your own. The design used in this project will be provided to you in class. This wall hanging has a quilted background. Once you understand how Karen created this project you can easily make your own unique applique quilts or quilted background for your own projects.

### Supply List

Husqvarna Viking Sewing and Embroidery Machine, Foot Control Pedal, Power Cord, Single Hole Stitch Plate, Utility Stitch Plate, Sensor Q foot, A foot, B foot, open toe foot, 360 mm x 260 mm hoop.

INSPIRA® Topstitch needle, size 80 or Quilting needle, size 75 (**Available for purchase at Patty's**)

40 wt. Embroidery Thread: Green to match or contrast to one of the green fabrics, aquamarine to match or contrast one of your turquoise fabrics, white to do the background quilting.

Embroidery Bobbin Thread (Full bobbin)

Monofilament thread

Construction thread (sewing thread) and matching bobbin to attach borders and the facing for the binding

Main fabric  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard white

Border fabric  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard (Floral in picture on the left-hand side) (will also be used for binding)

Green fabric - 3 coordinating colors  $\frac{1}{8}$  yard each

Turquoise fabric - 3 coordinating colors  $\frac{1}{8}$  yard each (if you do not have the color turquoise in your border fabric – you would want to select a color family that is in your border fabric and choose 3 coordinating fabrics for your applique flowers)

Fusible fleece - 1 Yd.

Fusible web for applique –  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd. (**Available for purchase at Patty's**)

Duck Bill Applique Scissors (to trim applique)

Rotary cutter with sharp blade and 24" long ruler

20  $\frac{1}{2}$ " or 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square ruler

Hand sewing needle

Fabric glue stick

Point turner

Non-permanent fabric marking pencil such as a Frixon marker

General Sewing Supplies and Tools (such as Pins, Snips, Scissors, Seam Ripper, Rotary Cutter with sharp blade; fabric marking pen, Rulers to mark fabric and stabilizer, etc.

**Prep for class:** Starch the white main fabric and the border fabric.
