“Springtime!” Towel



This month’s project will introduce you to the Design Shaping feature of our machines. We will also use the Group/Ungroup feature as we create our design elements. The use of the built in Embroidery Fonts can be used to customize your project. We will explore the Color Edit features on your machine and all of the icons on the machine used to create this project. I will demonstrate how to create a phrase using the word “Springtime!” as an example but you can customize your project with a phrase of your choice. You then have the option of embroidering the design on the bottom of a dish towel such as I have done with the class sample.

### Supply List

Husqvarna Viking Sewing and Embroidery Machine, Foot Control Pedal, Power Cord, Single Hole Stitch Plate, Sensor Q foot, 360 x 260 or 360 x 200 embroidery hoop.

Wash Away Stabilizer **or** Tear-A-Way Stabilizer to fit your hoop (**Available for purchase at Patty’s**) (You could use Aqua Magic wash away stabilizer in your hoop if you plan to wash your towel before using the towel.)

Dish towel to stitch out the embroidery design you create. The dish towel I used measured 19 ½” x 26 ½”. The design you will stitch out is 6” high by 13 ½” long. ***Recommend you prewash and starch the towel before class*** (so it will not shrink the first time it is washed after you embroidered it). **Do not** use a flour sack dish towel.

Embroidery Bobbin Thread to match the color of the towel. I used white.

40 wt. Embroidery Threads in colors of your choice. {I used 3 shades (light, medium and dark) of one-color family for the outline of the flowers, the inside of the flowers and the lettering. I used a green color for the leaves of the flowers, a gold color for the butterfly and a red color and black color for the ladybugs.}

HV Topstitch Needles, Size 80 (**Available for purchase at Patty’s**)

Non-permanent marking pen.

Ruler – at least 18” long to mark placement lines on towel and stabilizer.

General Sewing Supplies and Tools (such as Pins, Snips, Scissors, Seam Ripper, Rotary Cutter; Rulers to mark fabric and stabilizer, four curved safety pins, etc.)

### **Preparation before Class:**

**Machine wash and dry your dish towel. Then starch the towel.**
