Christmas Placemats
(Finished size is 12" x 16")



Let's use built in machine stitches, embroidery designs, Design Applique, Design Shaping and the Programming features of our amazing Husqvarna Viking machine to create Christmas placemats. This project is a great review of all the capabilities of the Programming, Editing stitches and designs; Design Shaping and Design Applique features. Built-in machine stitches and a letter to create the hanging chains for our applique ornaments will also be used. You could opt to use different colors; applique fabrics; different shapes and designs to create your unique project. The built in Lettering feature could also be used to further personalize your project. You do not have to make placemats but could adorn a home-dec item or garment with as few or as many of these individual designs. Not only does this project get us using our machine, but it also gives us a head start on some Christmas presents!

Supply List (Fabric for 2 Placemats-we will make 1 in class)

Husqvarna Viking Sewing and Embroidery Machine, Foot Control Pedal, Power Cord, Single Hole Stitch Plate, Utility Stitch Plate, Sensor Q foot, A foot, Open-Toe foot, Edge-Joining foot, 360 mm x 260 mm hoop.

HV® Topstitch needle, size 90 or Quilting needle, size 75

40 wt. Embroidery Threads for ornaments; could also opt to use metallic threads

Sewing thread and bobbin in a neutral color and to match/contrast with backing fabric

1 yd. cotton fabric for front of placemats: 2 pieces cut 15" x 19" (will be trimmed to size later)

1 yd. Backing Fabric: 2 pieces cut 18" x 22" (Christmas print in sample)

Small scraps of fabric used for applique (minimum size 3 ½" squares)

Heat-n-Bond Lite to fuse to the back of applique fabrics

Small applique scissors or snips

Tear away stabilizer to fit 360 x 260 hoop.

1 yd. Pellon SF 101, Fusible woven stabilizer: 2 pieces cut 15" x 19"

½ yd. Pellon 985F Two-Sided Fusible Fleece: 2 pieces cut 12" x 16"

Rotary cutter and mat with sharp blade and 24" long ruler

20 ½" square ruler with 45' marking

Quick Easy Mitred-Binding Tool by Sew Biz or a ruler with 45' marking

Point turner

Pressing cloth

Teflon pressing sheet

Non-permanent fabric marking pencil such as a Frixion marker or chalk -- need color that will show up on the backing fabric

General Sewing Supplies and Tools (such as Pins, Snips, Scissors, Seam Ripper, Rotary Cutter with sharp blade; fabric marking pen, Rulers to mark fabric and stabilizer, etc.

Prep for class: Starch the fabric used for the front and back of the placemats and cut to the measurements listed above. Fuse the SF 101 to the back of the fabric used for the front of the placemats.
