Let's Trim a Tree Table Runner





Finished size approx. 20" x 49"

This is our Christmas in July project! We will explore using sewing machine stitches and small embroidery designs in the embroidery mode to create the 10-inch-tall Christmas tree shape in the center block of the table runner. We will devote the class in July to creating and stitching out the center block. In August we will focus on the sewing side of our machine as we piece and quilt the table runner.

HV Sewing and Embroidery Machine, Embroidery Unit, Power Cord, Foot Control Pedal; 360 x 260 mm or 360 x 200 mm hoop or 260 x 260 mm hoop, both stitch plates, Sensor Q foot, A foot, ¹/₄" piecing foot, mini piping foot.

Embroidery machine needles # 80; Topstitch #80

Cut away stabilizer to fit hoop

13" square of background fabric with a 13" square of fusible fleece fused to the back

11/4" x 8" scrap for applique stitches (hanging ornaments on tree – optional)

40 wt, embroidery threads in Red, Green and Gold

Embroidery bobbin thread

Embellishments (optional) small buttons, crystals (I will provide red and gold sequins in class)

6 different Christmas fabrics -- will need two strips each cut 2" x Width of Fabric (WOF)

½ yd. Red Print fabric for border and binding

1 ½ yd, of Backing fabric (will need fabric 50" long x 22 wide)
