

## Supply List for September 2026 MYM Club

### Button Christmas Tree Pillow



Thank you for enrolling in the MYM Club. In our class this month (September) we will continue our exploration and review of the top features within our Husqvarna Viking sewing and embroidery machines. We will use our embroidery module and the Design Applique feature to create a triangle-shaped template to use as an outline when sewing buttons on the Christmas tree shape. We will also program and stitch out rows of sequin stitches in the embroidery module. The buttons are sewn on in the sewing mode which makes it super easy to sew on a variety of white buttons to fill the Christmas tree shape. The 16" pillow will have piped cording along the outside edge with an overlapped zipper closure on the back to create a very professional looking pillow. This project was inspired by a photo of a button project completed by Nadine Knecht, a Pfaff free-lance educator.

## Supplies

Husqvarna Viking r Sewing and Embroidery Machine, single hole and utility stitch plates, Foot Control Pedal, Power Cord; 360 x 260 hoop or 360 x 200 hoop.

Machine Feet: A, Sensor Q, Zipper Foot, Mega Piping Foot

Topstitch or Microtex Needle, Size 90

Tear-A-Way Stabilizer, 20" wide

Sewing thread to match background fabric with matching bobbin

White embroidery bobbin thread

40 wt. Embroidery thread: 2 shades of gold for star on top of tree and 2 colors for sequin stitches (I used metallic red and metallic gold thread)

White Sewing Thread – wind a bobbin with this thread also.

Variety of white buttons, approx. 200 to give you some variety – 2 hole buttons work best

Wash Away Thread

1/2 Yd. Background Fabric

1/2 Yd. Fabric for Piping

1/2 Yd. Fusible Woven Interfacing (SF 101)

2 yds of piping cord: 6/32" or 8/32" in diameter will work for this project

Grande Piping Tool ruler with 65 mm rotary cutter

Fabric marking pen, non-permanent that will show up on fabric

Rotary Cutter with sharp blade with a cutting mat (such as 10" x 16")

Ruler to draw placement lines on pillow background at least 18" long

Pressing cloth

General Sewing Supplies: Pins, snips, seam ripper, wonder clips, scissors

16" -18" nylon zipper

16" square pillow form

Flat sequins (if you want any color other than red or gold – I will have those colors and will provide you with enough sequins in red and gold to complete the project as in the class sample)

**See below for cutting instructions before class.**

**Prep Instructions before Class:**

Starch and press background fabric and piping fabric

Fuse fusible woven interfacing to the wrong side of the background fabric only

Cut:

Background fabric and fusible woven interfacing:

Cut one piece 17” square

Cut one piece 17” W by 8 ½” L

Cut one piece 17” W by 11 L

Piping fabric:

Cut one piece 15” square
