In addition, we will be exploring some of the wonderful quilting features within our machine and programming a saying to be stitched on our pillow.

Supply List

Designer EPIC Sewing and Embroidery Machine, Embroidery Arm, 360 x 260 hoop, Foot Control Pedal, Power Cord, Sensor Q Foot, both Stitch Plates, Interchangeable Dual Feed; Open Toe Foot; ¼" Piecing Foot; Gathering Foot; S Foot, Quilting Guides; Open Toe Foot, Gathering Foot

Inspira Tear A Way Stabilizer (Available for purchase at Patty's)

Inspira Stitch & Ditch Stabilizer (Available for purchase at Patty's)

¼" double stick fusible tape – such as Steam-A-Seam 2 (Available for purchase at Patty's)

Sewing thread to match fabric

Rayon embroidery thread for wording; Green rayon embroidery thread; Metallic embroidery thread

Flat sequins (will be provided to students in class)

(2) 1" buttons

4 different fabrics:

Fabric A – solid fabric

- 10" x 12"
- 2½" x 12"

Fabric B – pillow back

- (2) 12" x 9"

Fabric C – flowers

- 2" x WOF
- 2½" x 12"

Fabric D – leaves and strip

- 2½" x 12"
- 2" x 10"
- (5) 1½" squares

Cotton Batting:

- 12" x 16"

1/8" wide green ribbon, yarn or cord, 2 pieces each 12" long

12" or 14" zipper- we will be sewing decorative stitches on the outside of zipper's tape on the back of our pillow. **(White zippers are available for purchase at Patty's)**

Stylus (to help position sequins)

Embroidery Bobbin Thread

Straight pins

Rotary Cutter

Small ruler

Small applique scissors or snips

General Sewing Supplies and Tools (such as Pins, Snips, Scissors, Seam Ripper, Rotary Cutter with sharp blade; fabric marking pen, Rulers to mark fabric and stabilizer, etc.)
