### Christmas Tree Applique

Thank you for enrolling in the Mastering Your Machine Club for the HV Designer EPIC 2 and Designer EPIC machines. In our class this month we will continue our exploration and review of the top features within our Top-of-the-Line Husqvarna Viking Designer sewing and embroidery machines. We will use the Design Applique feature of our machine to create three Christmas trees. This design can be placed on a tea towel, table runner or a pillow top – the choice is yours. The class sample is stitched out on a tea towel. This project has lots of practice using icons and techniques we have used previously. These include the Design Applique feature with the Shape menu along with an excellent review and practice using the icons within embroidery edit. What a great gift for the upcoming holidays!



## Supplies

Husqvarna Viking Designer EPIC 2 or Designer EPIC Sewing and Embroidery Machine, single hole and utility stitch plates, Foot Control Pedal, Power Cord; 360 mm x 260 mm hoop **or** the 260 mm x 200 mm hoop

Machine Feet: Sensor Q foot; Utility Foot A, Edge-Joining Foot (if need to hem toweling)

Rubber Tipped Stylus recommended for programming.

Embroidery Needle, Size 80 (**Available for purchase at Patty's**)

Inspira Aqua Tear Away Stabilizer (**Available for purchase at Patty's**)

40 wt. embroidery thread – gold; brown, other colors to match/contrast with applique fabric used for threads

Embroidery bobbin thread

Sewing thread to match toweling (if using towel yardage and need to hem towel)

Non-permanent marking pen

Pre-made Towel, or toweling to make a tea towel finished size approximately 18" x 27"  
(**Available for purchase at Patty's – shop early for best selections**)

Cotton fabric for tree appliques:

8" square will be large enough for all 3 trees – may want to use different fabric for each tree – so bring enough fabric to accommodate your design choices

4" square of fabric for tree trunks (see photo of samples)

Heat and Bond Lite: 8" square and 4" square

SF 101 Fusible Interfacing if applique fabric is lighter in color than background towel fabric

Rotary Cutter with Sharp Blade

Appliqué scissors or snips

Clover Fabric folding pen (to fold hem lines if making tea towel from yardage)

General Sewing Supplies: 18" long ruler, pins, snips, 4 curved safety pins, seam ripper, scissors

### **Preparation and Cutting Instructions before Class:**

Prewash and starch the towel or the toweling fabric if making your own towel. Prewash and dry and then press the fabric used for applique. Fuse SF 101 to the back of any light colored fabrics.
