Fabulous Infinity Scarf

Thank you for enrolling in the HV Designer Using Your Machine Club. In our class this month we will continue our exploration and review of the top features within our fabulous Husqvarna Viking Designer sewing and embroidery machine. We will explore our dimensional applique stitches and sequin stitches to create a two-tone infinity scarf. We will look to stitch these out in the Sewing Mode first and then we will program the same stitches to be able to stitch them out in the Embroidery Mode. You decide whether you wish to stitch the designs for the project in the Sewing Mode or the Embroidery Mode! This project features Exclusive Stitch Techniques with dimensional applique stitches and sequin stitches. We will also use Design Positioning to align our stitch out. This will make a great Christmas gift for someone special on your list!

Supplies

Husqvarna Viking Designer Series Sewing and Embroidery Machine, single hole and utility stitch plates, Foot Control Pedal, Power Cord; 360 x 200 or 360 x 260 hoop

Machine Feet: A, J, S, Sensor Q, Clear Open Toe

2 yards of Fabric A Cotton Voile to cut 1(10"x 72") and one strip 2" by Width of Fabric (WOF)

2 yards of Fabric B Cotton Voile to cut 1 (10"x 72") and one strip 2" by WOF

Heat and Bond Lite (**Available to purchase at Patty's**)– to fuse under 2" strips of Fabric A and Fabric B.

Robison-Anton® 40wt rayon embroidery thread – 2 colors to match or contrast with your fabrics

Empty bobbin to wind matching embroidery thread

60wt bobbin thread

50wt cotton thread for sewing

INSPIRA™ 6" Appliqué scissors

Flat sequins (at least 25 each for Fabric A and Fabric B) (you can buy a spool of sequin trim at Joanns or Hobby Lobby or similar stores)

1(5") square of fabric and tear-away stabilizer to practice stitches

Embroidery Needle, Size 90 (New needle)

Inspira Wash Away stabilizer to hoop at least 5 hoopings

Rotary cut and small mat (**Note:** Rotary cutter blade must be sharp.)

Ruler to mark on stabilizer

Non-Permanent marking pen to mark on stabilizer

Hand sewing needle

General Sewing Supplies: fine pins, snips, seam ripper, scissors, small 6" ruler

Cutting Instructions before Class:

Cut from Fabric A: one 10"W by 72" L and one 2" by remaining width of fabric for applique

Cut from Fabric B: one 10" X by 72" L and one 2" by remaining width of fabric for applique

Heat and Bond Lite: pieces to measure 2" x 90"
