Personalized Stylish Cards



Thank you for enrolling in the HV Designer EPIC 2 Club. In our class this month we will continue our exploration and review of the top features within our fabulous top of line Husqvarna Viking Designer sewing and embroidery machine. Let's create some special one-of-a-kind cards using the exclusive stitch techniques, built-in stitches and sewing fonts and an applique design. We will program the elements of the designs in the embroidery mode to create three different cards. This fun and quick project will enable you to express yourself and create unique gifts that are simple and easy to replicate. The original project from Emily Baker, HV Educator, has been modified.

Supplies

Husqvarna Viking Designer EPIC 2 Sewing and Embroidery Machine, single hole stitch plate, Foot Control Pedal, Power Cord; 240 x 150 Metal Hoop with extra magnets or the 260 x 200 hoop

Machine Feet: Sensor Q

Inspira Embroidery Needle, Size 75 (**Available for purchase at Patty's**)

Inspira Cut A Way stabilizer (**Available for purchase at Patty's**)

5 Blank cards with matching envelopes (5" x 6.5" or 5" x 7") (I bought the cards used in the samples at Hobby Lobby in the section where they have all of the scrapbooking supplies but I

believe you could find them in any store selling scrapbooking supplies) (Note: We will stitch 3 cards out in class and cut 2 cards in half to use to back the embroidery stitch out. You could also use cardstock or a decorative paper to cover the back of the embroidery stitch out.)

RA 40 wt embroidery threads: green, gold, black, red, other color or colors to coordinate with flowers /ribbon for the applique flowers card

Embroidery bobbin thread (**Available for purchase at Patty's**)

Sequins (for Christmas card) (I have red and gold sequins you can use – if you want any other colors I suggest you buy flat sequins)

Ribbon, 10” long (see picture of applique flowers card)

Two 3” squares of fabric and one square 3 ½” of contrasting fabric for the applique flowers card; one 2” squares of 2 different contrasting fabric for balloons (in picture – the balloons with applique are orange and dark blue – yours can be any color of your choice)

Heat and Bond Lite: two 3” squares; one 3 ½” square; two 2” squares (**Available for purchase at Patty's**)

Marking Pencil; Markers, Crayons, Watercolor pencils and/or Coloring pencils (to color 3 single balloons, hearts, and gift box on the balloon card)

Applique scissors

Stylus

Glue Stick; Glue: White School Glue (to glue ribbon on card and to glue backing inside to card to cover the back of the embroidery stitch out

Perfection Embroidery Tape (**Available for purchase at Patty's**) or Blue Painters Tape

Rotary cutter to cut paper (TIP: I have one rotary cutter I designate to cut paper with)

Ruler – at least 12” long to use with rotary cutter and to measure card

General Sewing Supplies: Pins, snips, seam ripper, wonder clips, scissors
