

Supply List for the Marigold Quilt

Inspira Embroidery Design Collection: Marigold by Janet Sansom (**available for purchase from Patty's**)

Epic or Epic 2 Sewing Machine with Embroidery Arm, Power Cord and Foot Pedal, Sensor Q foot

Embroidery Hoops: **360 x 260 mm** and Mega Endless. Can use smaller hoops to embroidery design on sashing and cornerstones. (We will discuss options in class prior to the month we will be stitching out the sashing and cornerstones.)

Hoop Grip (**available for purchase from Patty's**)

Tear away stabilizer to fit 360 x 260 hoop and Inspira Fuse N' Tear stabilizer for the Mega Endless hoop (we will not be using endless hoop until second class.)

Embroidery Bobbin Thread - Black (**available for purchase from Patty's**)

40 wt. Embroidery Threads (**available for purchase from Patty's**) The designs used Robison Anton 40 wt Rayon threads. Feel free to substitute other colors or brand of threads. I have listed the colors used in the embroidery designs.

RA 2542, Foliage Green; RA 2545, Cypress (2 Spools of this color); RA 2333, Ginger; RA 2546, Crescent Moon; RA 2331 Mustard; RA 2329, Saffron; RA 2398, Visor Gold; RA 2247, Honey; RA 2330, Golden Poppy; RA 2581, Old Dk Texas Orange; RA 2205, Dark Rust; RA 2289, Rust; RA 2468, Texas Orange; RA 2263, Foxy Red; RA 2420, Tuxedo Red; Metallic Silver; Metallic Gold

12 yds. of 45" wide Black Cotton fabric for blocks, sashing, borders and backing

1 ½ yds. red tone-on-tone cotton fabric for cornerstones

2 ¼ yds green cotton fabric for sashing.

3 yds. of 60" wide Black Batting (If making the quilt using black fabric) (**available for purchase from Patty's**)

Black Sewing Thread

Scissors and Thread snips (**available for purchase from Patty's**)

Pins and four curved safety pins

Seam Ripper

Spray Starch

Monofilament Thread – Black or smoke (**available for purchase from Patty's**)

Rotary Cutter and 6 x 24 " long ruler

Non-permanent fabric marker that will show up on your fabric (I used an iron off chalk)
