

Supply List for Weathervane (8" Finished Block)

There's nothing but calm winds ahead with this Block on Board (BOB) die. Forecasts show creating this classic block without Y seams is a snap. Set it on point for a look that points to sunny skies!



How to Die Cut 4-Color Weathervane Block:

For best cutting results, starch fabric and position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is specially designed to cut one 4-color, Weathervane block in one pass through the cutter.

- Fabric Color 1: Cut **One** 3 1/4" square. Mark as A.
- Fabric Color 2: Cut **four** 3 3/4" squares. Place **right side up**. Pin or clip together and mark as B.
- Fabric Color 3: Cut **two** 6" X 4 3/4" rectangles. Fold in half longways, pin or clip together, and mark as **C**.
- Fabric color 4: Cut **Six** 5" x 2 3/4" rectangle. Place **right side up**, pin or clip together, and mark as **D**.
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SUPPLIES: Machine, Foot pedal, power cord. 1/4" Foot, Snips, pins, seam ripper, Construction Thread, filled bobbin, Travel Iron & Pad (if you have one) Highly recommended for this project as you will be doing a lot of ironing
