



Sewing Made Simple Series Drawstring Bag - Supply Sheet

In this class, students will learn essential sewing skills by making a simple drawstring bag. The project covers measuring and cutting fabric, sewing straight seams, creating a casing for the drawstring, and safely using a sewing machine. Students will practice basic construction techniques while developing accuracy and confidence. By the end of the class, each student will complete a functional drawstring bag that can be used for storage, school supplies, or gifts, and will have skills they can apply to future sewing projects.

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Pattern: ***It's a cinch by STUDIO2M*** (Available at AAA Sewing and Fabric)

Fabric: Quilting cotton or similar weight fabric

Main Fabric: (1) fat quarter or 3/8 yard

Lining Fabric: (1) fat quarter or 3/8 yard

Drawstrings: ½" wide twill tape or cording -1 ½ yards

Supplies: Notions and Tools

- 40-weight matching thread to your Main Fabric in the fabric and pattern kit.
- Sewing machine needles: Microtek or Sharps in size 80/12 or 90/14
- Awl or Stiletto tool
- Fabric Marker/ Erasable marking pen: Chalk, Mark-B-Gone, or Frixion
- Rotary cutter, and ruler (6" x 24")
- Measuring Tape
- Scissors:
 - Fabric
 - Paper
- Wonder Clips
- Pins

Sewing Machine and Power Cord: Cleaned and oiled ready to sew

- Sewing machine accessories provided by your machine's manufacturer
- All-purpose Foot
- Bobbins wound with the 40-weight thread.
