

## **How do I print and assemble my Sis Boom PDF patterns?**

Many customers like PDF patterns because the paper is sturdier and you receive your pattern quickly. Some seamstresses choose to print out the directions and some just follow along from their computer screen. One advantage is you don't have to deal with cutting out nested patterns sizes (thereby ruining other sizes in the nesting).

NOTE: There is a chart included with your pattern that allows you to choose the size pattern you plan to make and only print those pages containing that particular size.

When you select the pages to print, make sure your printer is set to "no scale" or 100%. Do not "shrink to fit" because this will distort the pattern. Most printers' defaults are already set to 100% but check yours to be sure. Once printed, the square box should measure as a 1" square on the pattern piece.

You will need to cut and assemble some of the pages to make a pattern piece (there are directions on how to assemble the pieces). Some of the pattern pieces fit onto one page so all you have to do is cut these out.

These patterns have a lot of detailed instructions, photos, and diagrams which makes these patterns great for the beginner and experienced as well.
