

HAVE ALL MATERIALS AT THE CURB BY MONDAY, APRIL 17.

Different materials are picked up on different days (subject to weather conditions) and may take several days to complete.

- > Keep piles away from utilities and meter pits.
- ➤ Old appliances (including dehumidifiers) must have Freon removed and be tagged by a certified technician.
- ➤ Materials must be sorted and separated into groups:

Construction/Demolition: dry wall, bricks, toilets, sinks, lumber

<u>Junk:</u> plastic pools, garden hoses, books, toys, lamps, vacuums, furniture, microwaves, mattress, box springs

Metals: water heaters, barbecue grills, lawn mowers

<u>Limbs/Thorny Brush:</u> manageable quantities placed parallel to the curb. Contractors YOU hire to cut down trees & limbs are required to haul them off.

<u>Bagged Yard Waste:</u> bagged leaves, grass clippings, spent garden waste. Do not mix any trash in with compostable waste.

> EXCLUDED MATERIALS

Normal recyclable materials ♦ day-to-day household trash ♦ hazardous wastes (motor oil, lead-based paint, car batteries, pesticides, etc.) ♦ liquids of any kind ♦ tires ♦ large amounts of wood, concrete, etc. Contractors YOU hire for remodel or demolition projects are required to haul off the materials.
