

## **North Newton City Hall Closed to the Public All City services remain operational**

The City of North Newton takes the health of our community and public employees who serve our community extremely serious.

As such, in light of the increase of COVID-19 cases, all City of North Newton facilities will close to the public starting Monday, July 20, 2020 until further notice. **If you have an emergency please call 911.**

All City services remain operational at this time. If you need to contact a city employee please call the office at 283-7633 and leave a message. We will do our best to return calls within 24 hours. Persons needing to make water payments or court payments are encouraged to place the payment in the drop box outside City Hall, mail them to City Hall or pay on line at [www.northnewton.org](http://www.northnewton.org).

The Police Department will be limiting face to face contact with citizens and closing their facility to outside traffic. However, the Police Department **WILL CONTINUE** to patrol and provide all essential law enforcement services to the public. Individuals with an emergency should call 911. Individuals needing to make a police report when it is not an emergency can call 911 to request an officer or call the North Newton Police Department at 283-3191.
