

ORDINANCE NO. 636-20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH NEWTON, KANSAS, REQUIRING THE WEARING OF MASKS OR OTHER FACE COVERINGS; PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, securing the health, safety, and economic well-being of residents of the City of North Newton is the priority of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the United States Departments of Health and Human Services declared a public health emergency for COVID-19 beginning January 27, 2020, with now more than 3,100,000 cases of the illness and more than 133,000 deaths as a result of the illness across the United States; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization declared a pandemic on March 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS, a State of Disaster Emergency was proclaimed for the State of Kansas on March 12, 2020; and

WHEREAS, as of 10th day of July, 2020, in Kansas there have been 17,821 reported positive cases of COVID-19 and 292 deaths; and

WHEREAS, after a steady trend of decreasing metrics, recent weeks have seen the numbers of COVID-19 cases, hospitalizations, and deaths spike in Kansas, Harvey County, Kansas and across the nation; and

WHEREAS, this increased COVID-19 spread is a danger to the health and safety of every North Newton resident and also presents a serious threat to the North Newton economy; and

WHEREAS, wearing a mask in public is an easy and effective way to protect each other and help keep our businesses open and our economy running; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Newton must remain flexible to account for the evolving nature and scope of the unprecedented public health emergency posed by COVID-19, while also simultaneously safely, strategically, and incrementally facilitating economic recovery and revitalization; and

WHEREAS, for the aforementioned and other reasons, and in recognition and furtherance of the City's responsibility to provide for and ensure the health, safety, security, and welfare of the people of the City of North Newton, requiring that masks or other face coverings be worn in

public spaces is necessary to promote and secure the safety and protection of the civilian population.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTH NEWTON, KANSAS, THAT:

SECTION I. DEFINITIONS. As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

1. Mask or other face covering" means a covering of the nose and mouth that is secured to the head with ties, straps, or loops over the ears or is simply wrapped around the lower face. A mask or other face covering can be made of a variety of synthetic and natural fabrics, including cotton, silk, or linen. Ideally, a mask or other face covering has two or more layers. A mask or other face covering may be factory-made, sewn by hand, or can be improvised from household items such as scarfs, bandanas, t-shirts, sweatshirts, or towels.
2. "Public Space" means any indoor or outdoor space or area that is open to the public; this does not include private residential property or private offices or workspaces that are not open to customers or public visitors.

SECTION II. MASK REQUIREMENT.

1. All persons in the City of North Newton shall cover their mouths and noses with a Mask or other face covering when they are in the following situations:
 - a. Inside any indoor Public Space where distancing of 6 feet between individuals is not possible at all times;
 - b. In line and waiting to enter an indoor Public Space;
 - c. Obtaining services from the healthcare sector in settings, including but not limited to, a hospital, pharmacy, medical clinic, laboratory, physician or dental office, veterinary clinic, or blood bank, unless directed otherwise by an employee or healthcare provider;
 - d. Waiting for or riding on public transportation or while in a taxi, private car service, or ride-sharing vehicle;
 - e. While outdoors in Public Spaces and unable to maintain a six (6) foot

distance between individuals (not including individuals who reside together) with only infrequent or incidental moments of closer proximity.

2. Businesses and organizations. In addition to the requirements included herein, all businesses, organizations and non-profit associations located in the City of North Newton must require all employees, customers, visitors, members, or members of the public to wear a Mask or other face covering when:
 - a. Employees are working in any space visited by customers or members of the public, regardless of whether anyone from the public is present at the time; or
 - b. Employees are working in any space where food is prepared or packaged for sale or distribution to others; or
 - c. Customers, members, visitors, or members of the public are in a facility managed by the business or organization; or
 - d. Employees are in any room or enclosed area where other people (except for individuals who reside together) are present and are unable to maintain a six (6) foot distance except for infrequent or incidental moments of closer proximity.
3. Exemptions. The following individuals are exempt from wearing masks or other face coverings in the situations described in Paragraphs 1 and 2:
 - a. Persons age five years or under; children age two years and under in particular should not wear a face covering because of the risk of suffocation;
 - b. Persons with a medical condition, mental health condition, or disability that prevents wearing a face covering—this includes persons with a medical condition for whom wearing a face covering could obstruct breathing or who are unconscious, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to remove a face covering without assistance;
 - c. Persons who are hearing impaired, or communicating with a person who is hearing impaired, where the ability to see the mouth is essential for communication;

- d. Persons for whom wearing a face covering would create a risk to the person related to their work, as determined by local, state, or federal regulators or workplace safety guidelines;
- e. Persons who are obtaining a service involving the nose or face for which temporary removal of the face covering is necessary to perform the service;
- f. Persons who are seated at a restaurant or other establishment that offers food or beverage service, while they are eating or drinking, provided they maintain a six (6) foot distance between individuals (not including individuals who reside together or are seated together) with only infrequent or incidental moments of closer proximity;
- g. Athletes who are engaged in an organized sports activity that allows athletes to maintain a six (6) foot distance from others with only infrequent or incidental moments of closer proximity;
- h. Persons who are engaged in an activity that a professional or recreational association, regulatory entity, medical association, or other public-health-oriented entity has determined cannot be safely conducted while wearing a mask or other face covering;
- i. Persons engaged in an activity or event held or managed by the Kansas Legislature;
- j. Persons engaged in a court-related proceeding held or managed by the Kansas Judiciary; and
- k. Persons engaged in any lawful activity during which wearing a mask or other face covering is prohibited by law.
- l. Churches or religious institutions (but churchgoers are encouraged to maintain social distancing).

SECTION III. PENALTIES.

- 1. The goal of this ordinance is to educate and encourage as many residents to wear facemasks in public – not to hand out tickets. If there is a concern, call North Newton City Hall at (316) 283-7633.

2. Any person, business or organization violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction.
3. A person, firm, or corporation convicted of a violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars upon a first conviction, by a fine of fifty (\$50.00) dollars upon a second conviction, and by fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) dollars upon a third or subsequent conviction.

SECTION IV. SUNSET PROVISION. This Ordinance shall be in effect until August 11, 2020 unless repealed or extended by the City Council.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its summary publication in THE HARVEY COUNTY NOW formerly know as the NEWTON NOW, the official newspaper of said City.
