

ORDINANCES

An Ordinance relative to Dogs
Ordinance No. 1

- Sec. 1. It is hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Alexandria, that no male or female dog shall be kept, owned or harbored within the corporate limits of said town, except the owner or keeper first obtain a license of the Clerk; such license shall be one (\$1.00) dollar for each male dog; and two (\$2.00) dollars for each female dog, per year, and to be paid by the first day of November of each year.
- Sec. 2. Any person harboring a dog shall be held liable for the aforesaid license.
- Sec. 3. It shall be the duty of the Marshall to kill any dogs owned, kept or harbored in said Town, the license upon which has not been paid.
- Sec. 4. The Clerk shall pay the moneys so received, forthwith to the Treasurer, taking his receipt therefore.
- Sec. 5. All resolutions heretofore adopted by the Board, not consistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- Sec. 6. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 22nd day of October, 1883.
