

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH GRADES UPON MAIN STREET, ALEXANDRIA,
DAKOTA

ORDINANCE NO. 10 (See #30)

- Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Alexandria, that all grades, in the Town of Alexandria, established by this Ordinance, or that may be hereafter is established by this Ordinance or that may be hereafter established shall be referred to an imaginary horizontal plane, called a datum plane, one hundred feet below a certain bench mark established November, 1883, upon the stone threshold, north door of the Hanson County Bank, on the east side of Main Street, between 5th and 6th Streets.
- Sec. 2. The height of grades referred to the datum plane described in Sec. One, is hereby established in feet and decimals of feet, upon Main Street, as follows:
Center of 3rd and Main Street, 97.75 feet
Center of 4th and Main Street, 96.75 feet
Center of 5th and Main Street, 97.75 feet
Center of 6th and Main Street, 96.75 feet
Center of 7th and Main Street, 97.75 feet
The grades at the crossings of these streets shall be level. The grade of all points intermediate between the points established at the intersections of the streets shall be determined by a straight line connecting the two nearest points specified in this Ordinance.
- Sec. 3. The curb line upon Main Street shall be six feet, and the cross streets shall be four feet from the lot line as given upon the recorded plat of the Town. The sidewalk upon this curb line shall be built to the grade of the center of the streets as described in this Ordinance and shall rise three inches to the lot line.
- Sec. 4. The ditch on the sides of Main Street shall be sixteen inches below the top of the curb street.
- Sec. 5. All ordinances and part of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.
