

AN ORDINANCE IN RELATIVE TO BLOWING STEAM WHISTLES

ORDINANCE NO. 11

- Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees in the Town of Alexandria, Hanson County, Territory of Dakota, that it shall be unlawful to blow any steam whistle within the corporate limits of the Town of Alexandria, except as is hereafter provided in Section Two.
- Sec. 2. It shall be lawful for whistles on locomotive, belonging to railroad companies, to blow their whistles in accordance with the regulations of said companies. Any steam whistle may be blown as an alarm, in case of a fire in town, or for not more than thirty seconds, at 7 o'clock in the morning, 12 o'clock at noon, and at 1 and 6 o'clock P.M.
- Sec. 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction be fined not less than one or more than five dollars, and costs of prosecution for each offense. It shall be the duty of the Marshall to see that this ordinance is enforced.
