

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DRUNKENESS IN PUBLIC PLACES

ORDINANCE NO. 112

Be it ordained by the City of Alexandria:

Any person who shall in this City be drunk or intoxicated in any place shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the County Jail of this County not exceeding thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
