

AN ORDINANCE TO GUARD AGAINST FIRE

ORDINANCE NO. 12

- Sec. 1. It is hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Alexandria, County of Hanson, Territory of Dakota, that it shall be unlawful for any person to light any fire outdoors within the platted part of said Town for any purposes whatever, without fire having attained permission of the Board of Trustees.
- Sec. 2. Any person violating the provisions of Sec. 1 of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Justice of the Peace of said Town, be fined in the sum of not less than one dollar nor more than twenty-five dollars and costs of the prosecution.
- Sec. 3. It shall be the duty of the Marshall to see that this Ordinance is enforced.
