

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO FIRES

ORDINANCE NO. 122

Be it ordained by the City of Alexandria:

That any person who shall in this City knowingly or willfully cause a false alarm of fire, or in any manner hinder or interfere with the work of the fire department of a fire at any time before the fire is wholly distinguished,, shall upon conviction of any of said offenses be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the County Jail of Hanson County, South Dakota, not exceeding thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. That this Ordinance shall take effect on the 20<sup>th</sup> day after its publication.
