

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING BILLIARD AND POOL ROOMS

ORDINANCE NO. 142

Be it ordained by the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. That it shall be unlawful for anyone to conduct, keep or maintain any room where billiard or pool tables are kept or used for gain or hire unless he first obtains from the City Council a license therefore at \$12.00 per annum for each table payable quarter annually in advance before the issue of the license certificate and the license shall cease whenever anyone in charge of such room violates any part hereof.
- Sec. 2. That it shall be unlawful for anyone under 18 years of age to enter any such room unless accompanied by his parent or duly appointed guardian during the whole of the time he remains therein and it shall be unlawful to anyone in charge of such room to suffer any such minors to enter such room or remain therein unless so accompanied; and it shall be unlawful to keep or suffer such room to be open between 12:00 o'clock P.M. and 9:00 o'clock A.M. or between 12:00 o'clock P.M. Saturdays and 7:00 o'clock A.M. Mondays; to conduct, keep or maintain a billiard or pool room as hereinbefore defined in violation of the foregoing prohibitions or of any of them is hereby declared to be a nuisance.
- Sec. 3. Anyone violating any part hereof shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not exceeding one hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the County Jail of Hanson County not exceeding thirty days imprisonment in the County Jail or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- Sec. 4. That all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances conflicting herewith are hereby repealed; this Ordinance takes effect 20 days after the publication thereof.
