

AN ORDINANCE IN RELATIVE TO BUCKETS

ORDINANCE NO. 15

- Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Alexandria that it shall be unlawful for any person to use any of the buckets purchased by the Town for protection against fire, for any purpose whatever, except the extinguishment of fires.
- Sec. 2. Any person who shall use, or have in possession any of the above named buckets for any purpose other than that specified in Sec. 1 shall be punished by a fine not to exceed ten dollars for each and every offense.
- Sec. 3. It shall be the duty of the Marshall to see as often as once a week that the buckets are full of water and to arrest, and bring before the Justice of the Peace for punishment all persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance.
