

AN ORINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF OIL TRUCKS

ORDINANCE NO. 155

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

That the operation of any oil truck of a capacity exceeding fifteen hundred gallons on any street, alley or other public ground of this City north of the paved highway is hereby declared and made unlawful and any violation hereof shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding Thirty Days or by both such fine and imprisonment; all conflicting provisions are hereby repealed; this Ordinance shall take effect of the 20th day after publication.
