

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON HIGHWAY 16

ORDINANCE NO. 157

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

That the operation of any motor vehicles upon any part of Highway No. 16 within the limits of this City at a speed exceeding 35 miles per hour shall be unlawful and any violation hereof shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment; all conflicting provisions are hereby repealed; this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and therefore shall take effect on its passage and publication.

Second reading: May 5, 1947
