

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING VEHICLES ON THE HARD SURFACED AND BLACK TOP STREETS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, HANSON COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA, PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFORE

ORDINANCE NO. 164

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. No person shall operate a motor vehicle or any other vehicle on the hard surfaced and black top streets and highways within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria, South Dakota, of a gross total weight exceeding ten thousand pounds.
- Sec. 2. No person shall operate a tractor or other vehicles on the hard surfaced and black top streets and highways within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria, South Dakota, with lugs and other attachments, which would injure and cause injury and damage to such surfaced streets.
- Sec. 3. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars or imprisonment in the County Jail not exceeding thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- Sec. 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
