

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO KINDS OF FUEL TO BE USED IN PRODUCING STEAM
IN STATIONARY, PORTABLE AND TRACTION ENGINES WITHIN CERTAIN LIMITS
OF THE TOWN OF ALEXANDRIA

ORDINANCE NO. 18

- Sec. 1. It is hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Alexandria, Hanson County, South Dakota, that within the portion of said Town bounded on the North by Eighth Street, on the East by East lin of said Town on the South by Railroad Street and on the West on West line of said Town. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, to use, burn or consume in the furnace of any steam engine, any fuel other than wood or coal for the purpose of generating steam therein.
- Sec. 2. Any person or persons, violating the provision of Sec.1 of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than One Dollar not more than Ten Dollars for each and every day such person or persons may use such fuel.
- Sec. 3. It shall be the duty of the Marshall to enforce this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be in full force on and after the 16th day of January 1886.
