

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING PUBLIC NUISANCES AND PROVIDING FOR THE ABATEMENT THEREOF AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE SAME.

ORDINANCE NO. 192

Be it ordained by the City council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. No person shall build or maintain or cause to be built or maintained within two hundred feet (200') of any city sewer or within twenty feet (20') of any well or dwelling house, any privy, privy vault, cesspool, septic tank or vat, upon any lot or premises in said City, and the building and maintenance thereof as above prohibited is hereby declared to be a public nuisance.
- Sec. 2. It shall be the duty of the Chief of Police of said City to serve a notice on any person who shall have built or shall maintain any privy, privy vault, cesspool and/or septic tank or vat on any lot in violation of Section 1, to abate the said nuisance within thirty days after serving said notice. If the person shall fail to abate said nuisance within the time herein fixed, it shall be the duty of the Chief of Police to remove or destroy such privy, cesspool or septic tank.
- Sec. 3. Any person who shall violate the provisions of Section 1 hereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00 and be imprisoned in the County Jail for not more than thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
