

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO AUCTIONEER'S ESTABLISHMENTS,
TRANSIENT DEALERS, AND PEDDLERS

ORDINANCE NO. 2

- Sec. 1. It is hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Alexandria, that it shall be unlawful for any person or persons engaging or being employed in any business or occupation hereafter mentioned; to engage or be employed in the business or occupation as transient dealer in any kind of goods or merchandise, whether selling at auction or otherwise, hawker or peddler in the streets within the limits of said Town, until such person or persons shall have obtained a license so to do; from the Board of Trustees of said Town, at hereafter provided.
- Sec. 2. It shall not be lawful for any person to engage, or be employed within the limits of the Town of Alexandria, in the business of auctioneering of transient merchandise or goods, until such person shall have obtained a license, so to do, from the President, and paid unto the Clerk the amount imposed by the President; such sum shall not exceed twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars and not to be less than five (\$5.00) dollars per day; said Clerk shall forthwith pay over all such sums, so received by him, to the Treasurer of said Town, taking his receipt for the same.
- Sec. 3. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to engage, or to be employed in the business of transient dealer or peddler until such person or persons shall have obtained a licensed, so to do, from the President of said Town, and paid to the Town Clerk such sums as the President may impose, such sums cannot be less than one (\$1.00) dollar, or more than five (\$5.00) dollars for each day engaged in said employment, and said Clerk shall forthwith pay over all such sums, received by him, to the Treasurer of said Town taking his receipt therefore.
- Sec. 4. It shall be the duty of the Marshall to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.
- Sec. 5. Upon non-compliance, or refusal of any person to comply with the provisions of this ordinance, he shall be fined, upon conviction thereof, not exceeding ten (\$10.00) dollars nor less then one (\$1.00) dollar and costs of prosecution.
- Sec. 6. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 22nd day of October 1883.
- Sec. 7. All resolutions not consistent with this Ordinance, heretofore adopted by the Board are hereby repealed.
