

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF FIRE WARDEN
ORDINANCE NO. 21

The City Council of the City of Alexandria do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. There is hereby created and established in and for the City of Alexandria the office of Fire Warden.
- Sec. 2. That it shall be the duty of the Fire Warden appointed by the City Council of the City of Alexandria in the months of April and October in each year, and at such other times as he may deem necessary, or as the City Council may direct, between the hours of sunrise and sunset, to enter and examine every house, warehouse, shop or building, and place for the keeping and depositing of ashes, chips, or shavings, and also to abate or remove any cause from which immediate danger from fire may be apprehended, and to cause all buildings, chimneys, stovepipes, hearths, oven boilers, ash houses, ash barrels, smoke houses and all fixtures, things and apparatus used in or about every building which shall be found in such condition as he may consider unsafe to be without delay at the expense of the owner or occupant thereof put in such condition, in the opinion of said Fire Warden as not to be dangerous in causing or promoting fire.
- Sec. 3. Said Fire Warden shall receive as compensation for his services, the sum of two dollars per day. The time to be employed not to exceed five days in each year.

This Ordinance shall take effect the 25th day of June, A.D. 1886.
