

AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC, WARNING DEVICES,
STOPPING AND PARKING THEREOF, AND PROVIDING THE PENALTY THEREFORE

ORDINANCE NO. 216

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. No operator of any motor vehicle shall stop or park his motor vehicle upon the streets or alleys in such a manner or under such conditions as to block traffic or to prevent free movement of vehicular traffic, except the operator may stop temporarily under such conditions when necessary in obedience to traffic regulations or police officers.
- Sec. 2. No person shall use any horn or other warning device on a motor vehicle otherwise than as a reasonable warning to traffic and shall not make any unnecessary and unreasonable loud or harsh sounds by reason of such horn or warning device.
- Sec. 3. No person shall drive a motor vehicle on any city street two or more abreast except when actually overtaking and passing another motor vehicle traveling in the same direction.
- Sec. 4. No person shall drive a motor vehicle in a chain procession of motor vehicles upon the streets of the City of Alexandria, South Dakota, when such procession repeatedly travels up and down the streets so as to obstruct and impair traffic or disturb the peace and quietness of the City. A person shall be deemed to have prima facie violated this section if he travels up and down Main Street more than three times in such procession.
- Sec. 5. No person shall drive any vehicle or motor vehicle upon any sidewalk or permit such vehicle to travel or remain on any sidewalk except at crossings or at permanent or temporary driveways.
- Sec. 6. Any person violating the provisions of Sections One, Two, Three, Four and Five of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the County Jail of Hanson County, South Dakota, for a period of not more than Thirty (30) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
