

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICERS OF NIGHT WATCH AND SPECIAL POLICE AND PROVIDING FOR THE POWERS AND DUTIES HEREOF

ORDINANCE NO. 22

The City Council of the City of Alexandria, so ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. That there shall be and hereby is constituted and created in and for the City of Alexandria, the office of night watch and special police.
- Sec. 2. There shall be one or more night watchmen, and one or more special policemen, who shall be appointed by the City of Alexandria Council.
- Sec. 3. Said night watchman shall constantly patrol, watch and guard the City from eight o'clock PM until seven o'clock AM each night, and it shall be their duty to arrest all persons violating the peace of said City of Alexandria, in any manner, or in any way violating the laws of the Territory of Dakota, or the ordinances of the City of Alexandria, and there is hereby conferred upon them, and each of them, for said purpose, all police powers now exercised as heretofore bestowed upon or given to the Marshall of said City by the ordinance of the City.
- Sec. 4. That the Mayor of said City of Alexandria, shall have the right, at any time to appoint such special police as he may deem necessary for the preservation of peace and order in said City.
- Sec. 5. The compensation of night watchmen, and special police to be fixed by resolution of the City Council and said compensation to be established but once during the year.

This Ordinance shall take effect the 25th day of June, A.D. 1886.
