

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING RECKLESS DRIVING, MAKING RECKLESS DRIVING A  
CRIMINAL OFFENSE, AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY THEREOF

ORDINANCE NO. 229

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. RECKLESS DRIVING. Any person who drives any vehicles upon a public highway or street within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria carelessly and heedlessly in disregard of the rights or safety of others, or without due caution and circumspection and at a speed or in a manner so as to endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property shall be guilty of reckless driving.
- Sec. 2. PENALTY. Upon conviction any person driving or operating a motor vehicle as set forth in Section 1 hereof shall be punished by imprisonment in the municipal jail for a period of not more than thirty (30) days or by a fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
