

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PRESERVATION OF GOOD ORDER AND THE
ABATEMENT OR NUISANCES

ORDINANCE NO. 23

The City Council of the City of Alexandria do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. Any person who shall make or assist in any riot or disturbance or who shall be guilty of any disorderly, indecent or insulting conduct, language, or behavior, who shall be in a state of intoxication in the streets or elsewhere in said City, and all persons who shall collect in bodies, or crowds in said City, for unlawful purposes to the annoyance or disturbance of the citizens or travelers, shall for each offence upon conviction before the police justice of mayor be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the city jail not exceeding the term of thirty days.
- Sec. 2. That it shall be a misdemeanor for any person or persons to throw or cause to be thrown in or upon any street, alley or public ground or vacant land within the limits of the City of Alexandria, any fruits, fruit skins, vegetables, vegetable meats, fish, manure, swill, slops, offal, or ashes.
- Sec. 3. That it shall be a misdemeanor for any person or persons to place or permit to remain in open air in or upon their premises any of the substances mentioned in Sec. 2.
- Sec. 4. That it shall be a misdemeanor for any person or persons to have or maintain upon his premises any pig sty, or pen, or cow, or cattle yard, abutting on any of the streets, or alleys within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria, that may be in an unclean or unhealthy condition, or to maintain any stable in an unclean condition.
- Sec. 5. That in case any person does not abate or remove any of the said nuisances from their premises within twenty four hours after being notified by the Marshall, or any member of the Board of Health so to do, the said Marshall may and it is his duty to at once abate and remove said nuisance at the expense of the City and for such expense so incurred he may recover, by civil action, in the name of the City of Alexandria, of the party delinquent, in that regard, three times the actual expense so incurred in the abatement and removing said nuisance.
- Sec. 6. That it shall be a misdemeanor for any person or persons to picket out any horses, cattle, asses, or other animals, with ropes, or any device, so said animals can get on any street, alley or public ground within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria.
- Sec. 7. It shall be a misdemeanor for any person or persons to have for a longer period of time than twenty four (24) hours exposed to the air or in any shed or out-building on his or their premises any dead animal not intended for food.
- Sec. 8. It shall not be lawful for any person or persons to make any indecent exposure, or show of any stallion or bulls in any public place, or within view of any dwelling house, or in any place where the same may be seen by persons passing on any highway, street, lane or alley in said City, and any person who shall make any indecent exposure of any stallion or bull in any of the above

named places, or any persons abetting or assisting in any such exposure shall be punished as hereinafter mentioned.

Sec. 9. No person shall slaughter or cause to be slaughtered any cattle, hogs, sheep, or other animals in any house, barn, outhouse, shed or other tenement, or in any yard, lot, street, or grounds within the limits of the City of Alexandria and no person shall hereinafter use or cause to be used any house, barn, outhouse, or other tenement within the limits of said City, for slaughtering cattle, hogs, sheep, or other animals therein.

Sec. 10. That whoever violates any of the provisions contained in any of the foregoing sections, after receiving twenty fours notice from the City Marshall shall be liable to a fine of not less than five or more than fifty dollars or imprisonment in the City Jail not to exceed thirty days, or both, in the discretion of the Court.

This Ordinance shall take effect the 2nd day of July, A.D. 1886.
