

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISTURBING OF THE PEACE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFORE

ORDINANCE NO. 231

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. Disturbing the Peace. It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully and wrongfully commit any act, which grossly disturbs the public peace within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria, South Dakota.
- Sec. 2. No person shall disturb the peace of the City or of any person by violent, tumultuous, or offensive conduct, or by loud or unusual noise, or by assaulting, striking or attempting to assault or strike another person, or inviting or defying another person to fight or quarrel, or by willfully or maliciously destroying or attempting to destroy or injure any property belonging to another or be engaging in a fight with another.
- Sec. 3. Penalty. Every person who is guilty of violation of Section 1 and 2 hereof may be imprisoned in the municipal jail for a period of not more than thirty (30) days, or may be fined in the sum of not to exceed One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
