

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING U-TURNS AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS, AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 176

ORDINANCE NO. 233

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. No vehicle shall be turned so as to proceed in the opposite direction upon any public street within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria, South Dakota, except at an intersection two or more streets, and subject to the right of the City Council of the City of Alexandria, to limit or prohibit the making of "U-Turns" at the intersection of any streets.
- Sec. 2. No vehicle shall be turned so at to proceed in the opposite direction or make a "U-Turn" at any intersection of any street within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria except at the following intersection:
- a. At the intersections of Main Street, U.S. Highway No. 16 and Third Street.
- Sec. 3. Any person guilty of violating any provisions of Section 1 and 2 of this Ordinance may be imprisoned in the municipal jail for a period of not more than thirty (30) days or may be fined in an amount of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or both such fine and imprisonment may by levied.
