

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE SALE AND SERVICE AND POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, NON-INTOXICATING BEER, AND WINE FOR CONSUMPTION UPON ANY PUBLIC STREET OR IN ANY VEHICLE UPON ANY PUBLIC STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, HANSON COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

ORDINANCE NO. 235

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. No intoxicating beer or non-intoxication beer, wine, or intoxication liquor shall be sold or served for consumption or consumed, upon any public street or in any vehicle on any public street within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria, South Dakota.
- Sec. 2. No persons shall be in possession of any intoxicating beer, or non-intoxicating beer, wine or any intoxicating liquor, where the cap or seal of the container thereof any been broken, upon any public street or in any vehicle upon any public street within the City of Alexandria, South Dakota.
- Sec. 3. No persons shall transport or convey beer, either intoxicating beer or non-intoxicating beer, wine, or any intoxicating liquor in any vehicle except in the original package with the cap or seal broken.
- Sec. 4. Any person found guilty of violating any sections or provisions of this Ordinance may be fined in an amount not to exceed One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or may be imprisoned in the municipal jail for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, or may be punished by both such fine and imprisonment.
