

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A FIRE DISTRICT IN THE CITY OF
ALEXANDRIA, DT.

ORDINANCE NO. 24

The City Council of the City of Alexandria, D. T. do ordain as follows, to-wit:

- Sec. 1. That it shall be unlawful without consent of the City Council for any one to erect or move upon any lot or part of lot fronting on Main Street north of the middle of Railroad Street and south of the middle of Sixth Street and for the distance of one hundred and fifty feet each way from Main Street within the above described limits any house or building over eight feet high or ten feet long except the entire walls be made of brick or stone or mortar, iron or other non combustible material, or to be vine red with brick or mortar.
- Sec. 2. Provided that incase of any violation of the proceeding section, it shall be the duty of the City Marshall to remove the same, and proceed to collect from the owner of lots or parts of lots on which said building is erected or moved; the amount of the cost of such removal together with fifty per cent penalty.

This Ordinance shall take effect the 2nd day of July, A.D. 1886.
