

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE #238, ORDINANCE #114, ORDINANCE #124, AND ORDINANCE #84; AND RELATING TO AND PROVIDING FOR THE LICENCEING, RESTRAINING AND CONTROLLING OF DOGS IN THE CITY OF ALEXADRIA, HANSON COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA

ORDINANCE NO. 246

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

- Sec. 1. That City Ordinances #238, #114, #124, and #84 are hereby repealed.
- Sec. 2. All persons owning of having under his control any dog within the Alexandria City Limits shall obtain a license for said dog from the City Finance Officer.
- Sec. 3. Dogs shall be licensed yearly, or before March 15th of each year.
- Sec. 4. The fee for the annual dog license shall be five (\$5.00) dollars.
- Sec. 5. The dog license shall be attached to the dog's collar at all times.
- Sec. 6. No person shall allow any dog which he owns or which is under his control to run at large within the corporate limits of Alexandria.
- Sec. 7. No person shall operate a dog kennel within the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria.
- Sec. 8. A dog kennel is hereby defined as any place or locations where five (5) or more dogs are kept.
- Sec. 9. Any person guilty of violating any of the sections of this Ordinance may be punished by a fine in an amount of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or may be punished by imprisonment for not more than Thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- Sec. 10. Each day that a person violated a section of this Ordinance shall be deemed a separate violation.
- Sec. 11. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.
