

ORDINANCE NO. 25 (see #56 and 119)

The City Council of the City of Alexandria do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. That no person as owner, agent, servant or employee, shall keep or drive any dray, cart, wagon or any other vehicle for the purpose of transporting for hire any goods, merchandise, or property other than material to be used in the construction of buildings in said city from one place to another in said city without first paying to the City Treasurer the sum of ten dollars for each year.
- Sec. 2. That no person, as owner, agent, servant or employee shall keep or run any omnibus, carriage, or any other vehicle, for the purpose of carrying passengers for hire in said City without first paying to said City Treasurer the sum of ten dollars for each year and obtaining a license therefore.
- Sec. 3. That any person who shall violate this ordinance or any part thereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than five nor more than twenty dollars and may be committed to city jail until such fine and costs are paid, and for any violation of this ordinance or any part thereof by any person having a license under and by virtue hereof said license may be revoked by the Mayor of said City at his discretion.
- Sec. 4. That this ordinance shall take effect the 2nd day of July, A.D. 1886.
