

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING ACTION REQUIRED AT A STOP SIGN

ORDINANCE NO. 251

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE City of Alexandria, that:

Except when directed to proceed by a police officer or traffic control signal, every driver of a vehicle approaching a stop intersection indicated by a stop sign within the city limits of the city of Alexandria, shall come to a full stop at a clearly marked stop line, but if none, before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection, or if none, then at the point nearest the intersection roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway before entering the intersection. After having stopped, the driver shall yield the right of way to any vehicle which has entered or is approaching the intersection from another highway or street and shall not proceed into the intersections until certain that such intersecting roadway is free from oncoming traffic which may affect safe passage.

Any person guilty of violating this Ordinance may be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or by a jail sentence not to exceed 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
