

ORDINANCE NO. 286
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Alexandria Volunteer Fire Department is in need of a different siren for use within the city limits of Alexandria; and

WHEREAS, there are not now sufficient monies in the fire department capital outlay budget for the purchase of said siren; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of the citizens of Alexandria, and in the best interests of public safety and welfare to have a siren that would be heard over a larger geographic area;

It was moved by Geppert and seconded by Weber that the following ordinance be adopted:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA that there shall be appropriated to the Fire Department Capital Outlay Fund the additional sum of \$3,000.00; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED (a) That the Street Department Capital Outlay Fund shall be reduced by \$1,500.00 and (b) that \$1,500.00 of the Contingency Reserve Fund shall be used to be appropriated to the Fire Department Capital Outlay Fund.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that these changes shall be applied to the city budget for the year of 1989.
