

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO LICENSING SHOWS, THEATERS, CIRCUSES,
MENAGERIES, AND OTHER SHOWS

ORDINANCE NO. 3

- Sec. 1. It is hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Alexandria, that it shall be unlawful for any traveling of transient person or persons to exhibit any circuses and menageries, or circuses and menageries combined, concert, or gift enterprises, or perform any play or plays, or games or theatrical or other performance of exhibitions whatever, for and fee, pay or consideration, within the limits of the Town of Alexandria, without having been previously licensed to do so, as hereafter provided.
- Sec. 2. Any person desirous of giving, making, or performing any show, gist, enterprise, game, performance, play, or exhibition, circus or menageries, as aforesaid, for pay or fee, shall make application to the President, or in his absence, to the Board, who may grant such license for circuses and menageries, upon the payment of not less than \$10.00 or more than \$25.00 per day and other exhibitions or shows upon the payment of such sums as they, or either of them, shall prescribe, but the sum shall not be less than one (\$1.00) dollar or more than twenty-five (\$25.00) per day. All such moneys shall be paid to the Clerk, who shall issue the license.
- Sec. 3. The Clerk shall pay over all moneys so received, by him, for such license, to the Town Treasurer forthwith taking his receipt for the same.
- Sec. 4. Any persons offending against any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined upon conviction thereof, not to exceed twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars or less than five (\$5.00) dollars and costs of prosecution.
- Sec. 5. It shall be the duty of the Marshall to close any of the exhibitions or places mentioned in Section 1 of this Ordinance, giving an entertainment which he may find open in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance and keep the same closed until compliance with requirements of said Ordinance.
- Sec. 6. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 22nd day of October 1883.
- Sec. 7. All resolutions heretofore adopted by the Board, not consistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
