It was moved by Smith and seconded by Waldera, that the following Ordinance be adopted:

ORDINANCE NO. 303  
AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SCHOOL BUS ROUTES WITHIN THE CITY OF  
ALEXANDRIA, SD

BE IT ORDAINED by the common Council of the City of Alexandria, SD that:

1. Routes. School bus traffic shall be permitted on the following streets within the city limits of the City of Alexandria:
  - (a) Seventh Street for State Highway 262 to Main Street;
  - (b) Main Street; and
  - (c) On any established truck route.
2. Severability Provision. If any provisions of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or the applicability hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the constitutionality of the remainder of the ordinance and applicability thereof to other persons and circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
3. Penalty. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance may be punished by being fined in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) dollars or incarcerated in jail for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
