

ORDINANCE NO. 31

The City Council of the City of Alexandria do ordain as follows:

- Sec. 1. That Main Street in the City of Alexandria be extended in width six feet on each side thereof, through its entire length from where Railroad Street crosses said Main Street north to where Sixth Street crosses said Main Street by taking appropriating, accepting and condemning by the City, for all streets and sidewalks purposes six feet of the front part of each side of said real estate bordering upon and contiguous to each side of said Main Street through its entire length as above stated.
- Sec. 2. That the City of Alexandria take and condemn under the power of the Eminent Domain that part of all lots and real estate necessary to carry into effect Section One of the Ordinance, which have or shall not be within twenty days after this Ordinance takes effect, otherwise deeded, granted or dedicated to the City of Alexandria, for the purposes set forth in Section One, to the satisfaction of the City Council.
- Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval and publication.
