BE IT ORDAINED by the common Council of the City of Alexandria, SD, that:

1. Section 3. Definitions., subsection ©. Ordinance Number 299, titled "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND CONTROL DOGS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA" be amended to read as follows:

"Kennel"-any place or location where more than **two (2)** dogs are kept at any time.
